If you're offered health insurance through VA, Medicaid, Medicare, your job or a family member's job, you probably don't qualify for help to pay your monthly premiums.

WHEN YOU CAN APPLY

Open enrollment: Nov 1st - Dec 15

Special enrollment: Anytime during the year if you have one of the events listed below that causes you to lose insurance. **YOU ONLY HAVE 60 DAYS FROM THE EVENT TO SIGN-UP.**

- Increase in income above 100% FPL
- Losing health coverage
- Birth / Adoption
- Moving
- Gaining new immigration status
- Getting married / divorced
- Changing jobs
- Turning 26 (if you were on your parent's plan)



WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

- Birthdays for everyone you claim on your taxes
- Social security numbers and immigration documents of everyone applying for coverage
- Information about your work: phone number and income
- Price of cheapest insurance plan if offered by your work

Adults without children who are not disabled do not qualify for Medicaid in Kansas.

WHEN YOU CAN APPLY

Anytime

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

- Proof of income for every person in the home: 1 month or 3 months if needing coverage for the last 3 months
- Person applying's ID
- Social security numbers and immigration documents of everyone applying for coverage
- Birth certificates and vaccine records of kids
- Current insurance cards of family members if you have them

WHAT IF I DON'T QUALIFY FOR MEDICAID OR MARKETPLACE?

Unfortunately, because Kansas doesn't offer Medicaid to more people, you may not qualify for health insurance at a reduced price. This is called the "Medicaid Gap".

Please bring the following to your clinical appointment:

1. Insurance card (if you have one)
2. Photo ID
3. Proof of address
4. If not insured, documents showing one month's worth of household income:
 - Most recent paystubs to equal 30 days
 - Most recent annual federal income tax return
 - Documentation of government assistance: Unemployment compensation, SRS cash assistance, Social Security or SSI
 - Disability determination with benefit amount
 - Documentation of child support/alimony
 - Letter on employer letterhead, signed and dated by supervisor
 - Financial award letter showing grants, scholarships, fellowships, or assistantships (Loans are not considered as income)
 - Self-Employed: Submit detail of the most recent three months of income and expenses for the business.

Adequate information must be made available to determine eligibility. Please submit a notarized letter from the individual assisting you financially and include the monthly monetary amount provided. In addition, we are unable to accept W-2s.
