Pediatrics – Well and sick child exams, physicals and immunizations. We work with Olathe and Shawnee Mission schools to identify students who do not have a regular pediatrician or dentist.

Dental Services – Comprehensive pediatric dental exam/x-rays, cleaning, fluoride, sealants, baby teeth removal, fillings and dental hygiene education.

Routine Health Care – Primary care services, acute care, annual physicals, chronic disease management, specialty care and prescription assistance.

Women's Health – Well-woman exams, pap/cervical exams, pregnancy test and birth control.

Behavioral Health – Brief assessments, interventions and consultations for pediatric and adult patients.

Substance Abuse – Outpatient treatment services and DUI Assessments for adults/adolescents and medication-assisted treatment.

Affordable Health Care – KanCare/Medicaid and Health Insurance Marketplace enrollment assistance.

Community Outreach – Connects patients with additional resources related to homelessness, dental and medical services.
