At Health Partnership Clinic, we are the designated medical home in Johnson County for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. This means our health services—medical, dental and behavioral health—are available free of charge to those who qualify. This service also extends to unsheltered people in Franklin and Miami counties.

How do I make an appointment?

At our Olathe location, call **913-648-2266** or stop by to make an appointment.

For those in Miami (Paola clinic – **913-294-9223**) and Franklin (Ottawa – **913-401-2750**) counties, please call to schedule an appointment. Same day or next day appointments are often available.

Are medications affordable?

Yes! If medication is prescribed by the clinic, a federal program called 340(b) allows participating pharmacies to dispense medications at vastly discounted prices.

Our staff is also experienced in assisting patients with pharmaceutical companies' patient assistance programs (PAPs), allowing patients to receive affordable medications.

No-cost COVID-19 testing and vaccines are available to adults and children. For details, please ask a member of our team.

What services are provided?

We treat a range of acute and chronic illnesses in addition to well checkups and physicals. Through our medical appointments, access to integrated behavioral health care is available with a behavioral health clinician. In addition, we offer Medication-Assisted and Substance Abuse services and limited dental care, at our Olathe location.

- Substance abuse and mental health treatment on site and/or by referral
